Rules for the Implementation of the Book-Loving Project: NTUT King of Presentation Competition at the National Taipei University of Technology, 1st Semester, Year 2018

Formulated on August 13th

I. Purpose of the event

This competition aims to promote language education and enhance NTUT students' expression capabilities through language, as well as to enhance their experiences on stage.

II. Themes of the competition:

- 1. An analysis on the pros and cons of artificial intelligence (AI) on human's future.
- 2. How to promote a living style with minimal plastics usage.
- 3. How to market NTUT.
- 4. Everything we should know about ethical education.

III. Time of the competition:

The first session will be held from 10:00-12:00 on Tuesday, November 20th, 2018 The second session will be held from 10:00-12:00 on Tuesday, November 27th, 2018

IV. Location of the competition:

Room B425 at the Scientific Research Building

V. Qualification:

All students at NTUT are free to sign up for the competition, regardless of academic program they belong to. (For freshman Chinese courses, one team is to be selected by the Chinese professor to join the competition; sign-up is to be done online.) Each team can only have between one to three members. Total sign-up limit is 40 teams, and each person is only allowed to join one team.

VI. Sign up procedure:

- 1. Please sign up at the <u>Center of General Education website by clicking the link</u>. Sign up deadline is **Tuesday, October 30th, 2018**. Late registrations will not be accepted. (Maximum of 40 teams will be taken, in the order of time of registration).
- 2. Please keep an eye on your email mailbox after you have signed up for the competition. Your registration will only be considered successful if you reply the email as instructed in the email sent to you.

VII. Rules of the competition

- The competition will be held in two sessions, both with the same judging criteria and the same judges. All teams' sessions and order of appearance will be drawn from a lot by the Center of General Education. The results will be announced on <u>Monday, November 12th</u> on the website of the Center of General Education.
- 2. It is mandatory that all competition participants attend the <u>Call Me King of Presentation</u> <u>course on Tuesday, November 13th</u>, before the competition is held. For details, see the website of the Center of General Education.
- Participants need to choose one theme from the themes given above, yet are free to decide on the titles of their works. Send in PPT files before Friday, November 16th. Name the file according to the following format: [NTUT King of Presentation Competition] Sequence-Name (Team)- Title of PPT.

- 4. On the day of the competition, participants need to present their student ID cards and show up between 9:30 and 9:55 for registration. Anyone who comes later will have their rights of competition forfeited.
- 5. Time will be started counting as soon as the participant speaks. At 3 minutes and 50 seconds, one short buzz will be given; at 4 minutes and 50 seconds, two short buzzes will be given. At 5 minutes, one long buzz will be given, signaling to end speaking. At 5 minutes and 10 seconds, two long buzzes will be given, and it is compulsory that speaking must end.

- 6. The results of the competition will be announced on Friday, November 30th on the website of the Center of General Education.
- 7. Online Poll for the Most Popular Participant: To be held between Friday, November 30th, 2018 and December 7th, 2018. The organizer will upload all participants' videos, and all fans and friends are encouraged to view the videos and vote for their favorites. One vote allowed per Facebook account. The top five participants receiving the most numerous of votes win. (The poll website will be announced on Friday, November 30th, 2018 on the website of the Center of General Education; poll results will be announced on Thursday, December 13th, 2018).

The top 5 participants are not allowed to take part in the Online Poll for the Most Popular Participant.

VIII. Judging criteria

- 1. Logical and rich content that stays in tune with the theme, and is overall complete: 40%
- 2. Beautiful and creative layout; uses various graphics: 30%
- Presentation style: includes demeanor, oral expression capabilities, familiarity with content: 30%
- 4. Time: 5 points will be deducted if the presentation is under 4 minutes or over 5 minutes.
- **IX. Judges:** Chinese teachers/professors from NTUT and other schools.
